Christine and I attended the District Presidents Meeting last Friday. Part of the meeting was devoted to the Districts Annual General Meeting.

The appointment of the District Governor 2023-2024 was approved. Ian Ballantine of the Rotary Club of Bentley Moorabbin Central to serve as District Governor

From the District audited report it was noted that district funds showed an operating surplus of \$26,545.00 ending 30th June 2021 the surplus was distributed by \$10,000 to the Emergency Relief Fund and \$16,545 to the District Development Fund
